

## **BPWGC BOARD MEETING**

August 9, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 12:15 pm. Rose Hall was absent.

**PRESIDENT** - We are asking for designated drop areas for holes 6 and 13. Also for red stakes on hole 16.

**TREASURER** - The budget is in good shape. \$11,417.79 in the General Fund. Report submitted.

**MEMBERSHIP** - The Board approved to keep dues at \$105.00. The board also approved on-line renewal for membership. SCGA is providing this "service". Payment must be made by credit card. GHIN registration will be included (\$36). Members must request an SCGA refund, just like last year, if they belong to multiple clubs. The Board will check to assure that the Weekenders will also be able to renew online as a sub-group of the Thursday players.

**VP/TOURNAMENTS** - The Board agreed that that the maximum handicap for tournaments would be set at 40.

**HANDICAP** - Most members are posting their scores.

**SWEEPS** - There was a member complaint about how the flights were being adjusted. Ann provided a chart to show the difference in results when the flights were equalized vs the flights being determined by handicap. The Board agreed to continue equalizing the flights. Chart provided.

**HOSPITALITY** - The President's Cup Luncheon was a big hit and the ladies enjoyed it. Six former presidents attended. The next event is the Turkey Trot Shotgun golf and General Meeting. Members will provide sweets.

**RINGER** - First quarter (January-April) results will be posted on the web site.

**PUBLINKS** - The board agreed that BPWGC would not participate in Pub Links next year due to the lack of opportunities to play in South County which resulted in fewer members participating in PubLinks. The PubLinks event scheduled at Balboa on August 9th was canceled due to lack of interest.
