

**BPWGC BOARD MEETING  
APRIL 30, 2020**

The meeting was called to order at 11:00 am on April 30, 2020.

**Absent:** All were present at the virtual meeting.

**President** - Jennie discussed the status of the golf course and the changes made to comply with the COVID-19 rules. At this time, both the 9 hole and the 18 hole courses are open. All golfers must reserve a tee time online. No walk-ons. The putting green is unavailable. The driving range will be available. Carts will probably not be available. If available, only one person to a cart unless you're in the same family. So, walkers only at this time. Toby's will not be open for sit down eating, only for carry out orders. Payment will be by credit card only for golf and/or food. Jennie will monitor changes and send updates to members via email. Linda will make adjustments to the calendar to reflect new dates for Ace day, games, etc.

New carts coming in July.

**Tournaments and Sweeps:** Temporarily suspended for 2 weeks ( May 7 and 14). At that time, carts should be available, so all members will be able to play. Online tee time sign- up sheet may be adjusted to record gross and net scores. Details to follow, if there are changes.

Rules for opening - A Balboa employee will take your temperature upon arrival. You must wear a mask until you begin golfing. No scorecards will be available. Use an app on your phone or bring your own paper to record scores. If using paper, 2 players per " card". Scores must be reported on GHIN using the hole-by-hole feature. Don't touch the flag poles. If you hit into the sand, smooth it out with your feet after you hit out.

Tee Times - Tee times will be adjusted from 8 minutes apart to 10 minutes apart.

Partner Eclectic Day 2 - currently scheduled for May 28, if carts are available.

Ringer - is temporarily suspended.
