

Membership & Eligibility Procedures

Membership Home Course Dues are **\$105** per year. This fee includes:

- \$21 dues
- \$38 for Sweeps Tournaments and Hole in One
- \$36 HDCP – SCGA
- \$ 5 City Assessment
- \$ 5 Improvement Assessment

Renewals are now done electronically through the SCGA. Go to scga.org and click on the "renew" button on the left. Type in "Balboa Park Women's Golf Club" and click on the search button on the right. Scroll down and you'll notice a lot of information about the club...and most importantly a "JOIN NOW" button. If you click the join button you'll be prompted through a series of steps to join the club. The system can handle different kinds of memberships.

Thursday members can join the club and put in their \$5 Ringer money at the same time. If you are a Thursday member that also plays on Saturday, you may put in the extra \$12 for the Saturday Sweeps. Saturday members are requested to add the \$12 Sweeps to their dues.

Beginning January 1, 2019, all players must produce a resident card in order to play at the Resident or Senior Rate. Items used to prove residency are listed on our website, bpwgc.net.

For those of you that are NOT CITY RESIDENTS, you may still join the club. The City has offered a special "BALBOA PLAYERS CARD". First, purchase a single Player's Club Card for \$10 for 5 plays at either the 9-hole or 18-hole course, which will allow you to play at the Resident or Senior rate. The second option is to purchase a one year Player's Club Card, at a cost of \$90 for 45 rounds on either the 9-hole or 18-hole course, allowing you to play at the Resident or Senior rate. The card is ONLY valid at Balboa Park Golf Course and may be purchased in the Pro Shop.

Eligibility

We welcome all prospective members to our club. For your enjoyment and that of your playing partners, we highly suggest that you have a basic knowledge of the Rules of Golf and are able to score in the 135 range before joining the 18-hole Balboa Ladies Club. If you cannot score in this range, please consider joining the 9-hole group that plays on Tuesdays and Fridays, or the Mission Bay Par 3, which plays on Wednesdays.

Members without an established handicap will be required to play a 5 game series on Thursday Play Day with at least one member of the club, to establish a handicap. The first three games must be played with a board member. New members transferring from areas not registered by the WPLGA must present a transcript of their last 20 differentials to the Handicap Officer and pay applicable dues, sweeps, handicap and assessment. To apply for Weekend Membership only, a player must play 2 games with a member and 3 other games at Balboa any day of the week. Turn in at least 5 attested scorecards to the Weekend Chairperson.
